Reply to Labour Party LGBT Network questions:

1. Do you accept that trans women are women, trans men are men, and non-binary people are non-binary - and will you commit to respecting trans people as their self-declared gender – if so, how will you integrate this approach to tackle the culture of entrenched transphobia, from the grassroots membership up to the leadership?
2. Will you defend the current Labour Party policy and principle of inclusion of Transgender women on All Women Shortlists?

1. "Yes and yes. I will integrate this approach through Training for members in regard to trans rights and appropriate language to use around trans people and this training will be delivered by trans members. I will respect trans peoples self declared gender. I will not misgender any trans men or women and use the correct pronouns for non-binary people and will ensure that other Labour members from the membership to the leadership follow suite."
