Laura Pidcock was an MP who lost her seat in the 2019 General Election. She is known to have supported women's sex-based rights in the past.

As a member of the Centre Left Grassroots Alliance, she is party to their agreed statement, which includes:

"Labour should be a great force for equality, intersectionality and workingclass unity. We must stand with the Black Lives Matter movement and achieve lasting structural change. We must campaign against all forms of racism including antisemitism, Islamophobia and Afriphobia and the scapegoating of migrant and Traveller communities. We must challenge discrimination and prejudice wherever it occurs, including tackling sexism, sexual harassment, homophobia, biphobia, transphobia and ableism. We will build inclusive self-organised equality structures in the Party, and strengthen our candidate selection processes accordingly."

Laura Pidcock did not reply to the letters from either the Labour Party LGBT Network or the Labour Women's Declaration Working Group.
